

# Explore post-graduate opportunities at UiTM fair

THE Institute of Graduate Studies (IGS) at Universiti Teknologi Mara (UiTM) will hold its Post-graduate Education Fair and Exhibition (PEFF) at the Kuala Lumpur Convention Centre for three days, starting from Tuesday.

The fair, the largest ever organised by IGS, coincides with the 35th International Federation of Training and Development Organisations (IFTDO) Conference and Exhibition.

The PEFF and IFTDO conferences are held at the same venue and UiTM has been given the honour to host both.

The current president of IFTDO is UiTM vice-chancellor Datuk Seri Prof Dr Ibrahim Abu Shah. The university also celebrates its 50th anniversary this year.

As UiTM is on course to becoming one of the most eminent local public institutions, it seeks to foster a dynamic research culture. It seeks to foster vibrant academic staff and post-graduate research student ties to complement a research-based community.

They will, in turn, contribute to research output for the public through interactions with industrial, commercial and government partners.

IGS dean Prof Datin Dr Zubaida Alsree said: "The next intake at year-end will see 86 master's and doctoral programmes, compared with 25 in 2000.

all aspects such as teaching, learning research and publications."

Several new programmes have been given the green light recently by the Higher Education Ministry to be offered for the next intake at year-end.

The programmes are Master of Science (property investment), Master of Science (heritage and conservation management), Master in Library Science, Master of Science (plantation industry management), Master in Engineering management, Master of Media and Information Warfare, Master/PhD of Health Sciences and Master/PhD of Artistic and Creative Technology.

The Master of Science (property investment) is for those

seeking to enhance their careers in the fields of property investment, development and management.

The Master of Science (heritage and conservation management) caters to the needs of the built and natural heritage in Malaysia.

The Master in Library Science provides professional knowledge and competencies needed for a career in libraries and resource centres in the business and industrial sectors.

The Master of Science (plantation industry management) is designed to fulfil the vision of transforming the agricultural sector into a modern and commercially-viable one.

The Master in Engineering Management equips engineers

and professionals with related management tools.

The Master of Media and Information Warfare provide students with philosophical, theoretical and professional knowledge on media and information warfare.

The Master/PhD of Health Sciences (by research only) is from the faculty of Health Sciences which offers post-graduate research in areas such as medical radiation physics, medical biotechnology and reproductive physiology and virology.

The Master/PhD of Artistic and Creative Technology (by research only) meets the demand of globalisation.
