

## **Pullout by students, for students**

KUALA LUMPUR: Universiti Teknologi Mara (UiTM) students are learning the "do's and don't's" of producing a newspaper.

The students will produce a monthly pullout section that will be featured for eight months in the New Straits Times from Oct 7 to April 25 next year.

Entitled "Journalism on Campus", the 24-page pullout is a joint project by the university and NST. Produced by UiTM students, the paper will carry campus news.

A total of 14,200 copies will be printed and distributed in campuses across the peninsula.

Students from different faculties are currently undergoing practical and classroom training with New Straits Times at Balai Berita in Bangsar before "graduating" on Aug 10.

The training is for eight days where students learn a wide range of skills like reporting, news writing and editing.

Students learned about advertising and marketing at yesterday's session from 10am to 6pm.
