KUALA LUMPUR, April 6 (Bernama) -- Malaysia's second Prime Minister, the late Tun Abdul Razak Hussein, will always be remembered by his family members as the source of inspiration and motivation for them to succeed.

His fourth son, Datuk Mohamed Nazim Tun Abdul Razak, said his father's wisdom as the country's leader and head of the family was the main source of motivation for the family to work hard and to succeed in whatever field they ventured in.

"Among Tun's approach in encouraging us to do well in our studies when we were in primary school was to give us RM30 if we are first in class, RM20 for second place and RM10 for third place in the term examinations," he said in his speech in conjunction with the opening of the Tun Razak Leadership programme and presentation of the Tun Abdul Razak award to Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia (UKM)'s best student here today.

Mohamed Nazim, who is the Tun Razak Foundation Alumni Association advisor, said his late father led a moderate life.

"Tun had the common touch and was able to make time for the ordinary people. He would make a point to meet the people who had waited to see him, even for a few minutes, at Sri Taman or his office," he added.

At the function, Mohamed Nazim presented the Tun Abdul Razak awards to Nur Ehsan Said, 25, who graduated with a bachelor's degree in teaching (Teaching English as a Second Language - TESL), and Christina Ong Sook Beng, 24, who graduated with a degree in English Studies.

Also present was Tun Razak Foundation chairman Tun Mohammed Hanif Omar.
