UniRazak inks Islamic finance course deal

UNIVERSITI Tun Abdul Razak (UniRazak), one of the country's leading private universities in the areas of innovation, leadership, and entrepreneurship, recently signed a memorandum of agreement (MoA) with International Centre for Education in Islamic Finance (INCEIF).

The agreement was signed at Bank Negara by UniRazak president and vice-chancellor Professor Datuk Dr Md Zabid Abdul Rashid and INCEIF president and chief executive officer Daud Vicary Abdullah.

UniRazak is a private university providing undergraduate, graduate and postgraduate courses and qualifications.

INCEIF is a private university providing postgraduate programmes in the area of Islamic finance.

Through this collaboration and agreement, UniRazak adapts modules of INCEIF's Chartered Islamic Finance Professional (CIFP) programme into its Bachelor in Business Administration (Islamic banking & finance) programme.

This includes Islamic accounting practices, Islamic economics, Islamic capital markets, Islamic law of contracts, Islamic financial institutions and markets, deposit mobilisation and financing management, *fiqh muamalat* and wealth planning and management.

Students and graduates of UniRazak's Bachelor in Business Administration (Islamic banking & finance) programme will then be eligible to apply for exemptions to INCEIF provided that they achieved a score of at least 60 per cent for each course.

Students who have been granted exemptions qualify to enrol into the Chartered Islamic

Finance Professionals (CIFP) programme or other equivalent programmes at INCEIF.

It also entitles students and graduates of the bachelor's programme to apply for membership of the Association of Chartered Islamic Finance Professionals (ACIFP).
